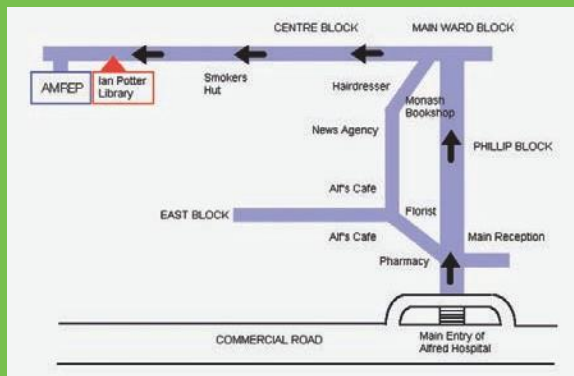

Behavioural Emergencies Webinar

Friday 30th June 2017

Working with people expressing suicidality or self harm can be extremely challenging. It may raise questions such as: when should you be concerned? How should you respond? What should you do? This seminar will introduce participants to risk assessment for suicide. Differences between suicidality and self harm presentations will be discussed. Participants will gain insight into statistical profiles and at risk populations. Collaborative work and triage with people experiencing suicidal ideation will be covered as well as the concept of risk care planning.
